****New Bulk Trash & Electronics Recycling Schedule****

Bulk trash will now be collected **EVERY** Thursday for Zone 1 and **EVERY** Friday for Zone 2. Please note that **ONLY THREE** (3) **Bulk items**, per household, can be put out for bulk on these days. There will not be any other bulk pickups during the year. If you are in need of a major bulk pickup, call DPW and schedule a dumpster. All metal must be collected separately. It will be picked up on the last working day of the month by appointment only. Please call DPW at 732-741-0522. If snow is covering bulk trash, it must be cleared of snow before pickup or it must be taken off the street. Electronic recycling is now mandatory. Please do not put electronic items out for trash or bulk pick up as they will not be collected. The following is a list of electronic items that must be recycled: Computers, Stereo Components, CPU's, Televisions, Keyboards, Radios, Mouse, Cameras, Monitors, Telephones, Scanners, Copiers, Printers, Fax Machines, Cables, VCR's, Laptops, DVD Players, and Peripherals. You must make an appointment to recycle your electronics by calling the DPW office at 732-741-0522.
