WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-78b has authorized the Local Finance Board to adopt rules that permit municipalities in sound financial condition to assume responsibility, normally granted to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, of conducting the annual budget examination, and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 5:30-7 was adopted by the Local Finance Board on February 11, 1997, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-7.2 thru 7.5 the Borough of Island Heights has been declared eligible to participate in the program by the Division of Local Government Services, and the Chief Financial Officer has determined that the Borough meets the necessary conditions to participate in the program for the 2013 budget year.

- The budget and associated amendments have been introduced, publicly advertised, and adopted in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Local Budget Law, except that failure to meet the deadlines of N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-5 shall not prevent such certification.

WHEREAS, the County of Monmouth has entered into an agreement with Sunrise Systems, Inc. (“Sunrise”), whereby the County is licensed to access and use Sunrise’s web-based system known as the Open Public Records Search System – Records Information Management (“OPRS-RIM”); and

WHEREAS, under the terms of its agreement with Sunrise, the County of Monmouth may sublicense access and use of OPRS-RIM to municipalities/boards of education within Monmouth County; and

WHEREAS, the County of Monmouth, has offered to enter into a shared services agreement with Borough of Shrewsbury, for a three (3) year term whereby this municipality/board of education will be authorized as a sublicensee to access and use OPRS-RIM; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the agreement is attached to this resolution; and

WHEREAS, the OPRS-RIM provides for the Inventory Management, Retention Management, and Disposition Management of official records and includes an imaging module that permits the scanning of paper records into TIFF images, which may be stored long-term, searched and retrieved electronically.
